2024 GROCERY GETTER RULES

• GENERAL RULES - All vehicles must come to the track RACE READY; Car numbers MUST BE BIG & EASY TO READ on both sides and top. All glass, headlights, & taillights except windshield should be removed along with other excess parts like spare jack, spare tires, old parts, trash, etc. Interior must remain in stock condition. 4 & 6-cylinder cars, SUV's & minivans are eligible with a maximum of 22 feet in length. No 4wd vehicles unless driveshaft removed making it 2wd. No Trucks. Stock fuel tanks only. The ONLY added reinforcements eligible (but not required) are an outside bar or plate to the driver's door. No roll cages. Must remove airbags. Can remove the catalytic converter but must be fully replaced with pipe. Must have a muffler. THIS IS NOT INTENDED TO BE A RACE CAR! Tech decisions are final.

No additional passengers will be allowed in the vehicle

- <u>DRIVER EQUIPMENT</u> Must wear long-sleeves & long pants (fire suit recommended)
 Neck collar is required, Helmet must meet or exceed the 2010 SA Snell or SFI 31.2
 standard. Helmet must be ALWAYS worn while on track (even while in the infield)
- MEETING There will be a driver's meeting at the event. Attendance is MANDATORY.
 Race guidelines will be discussed. Questions can be asked and answered there.
- <u>ENTRY FEE</u> There is NO car entry fee. Each person that enters the pit area will be required to purchase an event pit pass.
- PURSE 1. \$1000 2. \$500 3. \$300 4. \$200 5. \$150
- SCORING TRANSPONDER A scoring transponder and pouch are REQUIRED.
- RACE LINEUP(S) A blind draw for starting spots will be made as each driver signs in for
 the event and gets their transponder. The draw will stop at the start of the drivers
 meeting with those signing up after the meeting being added to the tail of the starting
 lineup.
