



2025 GROCERY GETTER RULES

VEHICLE INFORMATION

- A.** Eligible Vehicles – 4-cylinder & 6-cylinder cars, small SUVs, and minivans with a maximum of 22' in length. No 4WD or AWD or full-size vehicles. No trucks. No convertibles.
- B.** Preparation – All vehicles must come to the track RACE READY. Removing glass and debris on Anderson Speedway property will result in being asked to leave without a refund.
- C.** Fuel Tank – Stock fuel tank in stock location only.
- D.** Glass – All glass, headlights, and taillights must be removed EXCEPT for the front windshield. Sweep clean from vehicle before coming to the track.
- E.** Sunroof – It must be removed, and the opening fully covered by steel or sheet metal.
- F.** Interior – All interior must remain in stock condition including seats.
- G.** Debris – ALL excess loose items must be removed such as jack, spare tire, trash, etc.
- H.** Seatbelts – Must have working factory seatbelts and must be used properly AT ALL TIMES while on track.
- I.** Doors – Must be fastened, chained, or welded shut.
- J.** Reinforcement – The only added reinforcements allowed are an outside steel bar or steel door plate on the driver's door and/or passenger door. No roll cages or roolbar.
- K.** Airbags – Must be removed.
- L.** Exhaust – Must remain stock and stock sounding with a working muffler. Catalytic converter may be removed but must be fully replaced with exhaust pipe.
- M.** Tires – Regular Street DOT tires are required. No High performance/racing tires or slicks. No run-flats. When tires go flat, you pull off the track. Track has final say.
- N.** Numbers – Car numbers must be big, bold and EASY TO READ with a simple font. Must be on both sides and on the roof. Adding single letters is recommended with the high car count. Track may ask you to add a letter if needed.
- O.** Overall – These are NOT intended to be race cars, just a way to have fun. All tech and track decisions towards eligibility are final.
- P.** All vehicles must have a window net
- Q.** No passengers will be allowed

DRIVER EQUIPMENT

- A.** Must wear long-sleeves & long pants (fire suit recommended).
- B.** Neck collar is required, Helmet must meet or exceed the 2010 SA Snell or SFI 31.2 standard. Helmet must be ALWAYS worn while on track (even while in the infield).
- C.** Drivers must have gloves on.

MEETING - There will be a driver's meeting at the event. Attendance is MANDATORY. Race guidelines will be discussed. Questions can be asked and answered there.

ENTRY FEE - There is NO car entry fee. Each person that enters the pit area will be required to purchase an event pit pass.



PURSE - 1. \$1000 2. \$500 3. \$300 4. \$200 5. \$150

SCORING TRANSPONDER - A scoring transponder and pouch are REQUIRED.

RACE LINEUP(S) - A blind draw for starting spots will be made as each driver signs in for the event and gets their transponder. The draw will stop at the start of the drivers' meeting with those signing up after the meeting being added to the tail of the starting lineup.
